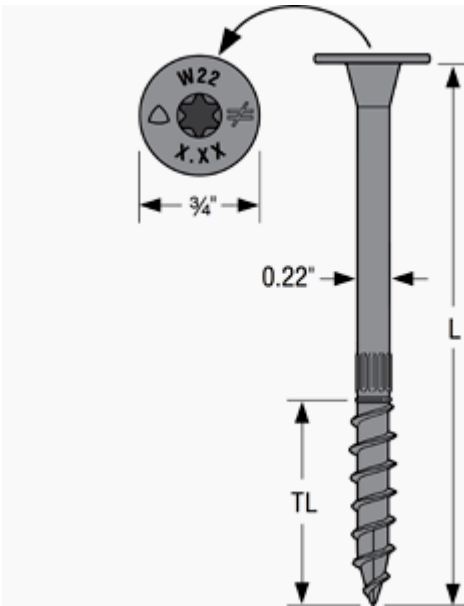

STRONG DRIVE STRUCTURAL WOOD SCREWS

The Strong Drive SDW wood screw manufactured by SIMPSON STRONTIE is a .22" diameter, high strength structural wood screw specifically designed for fastening multi-ply wood members such as plated trusses, engineered lumber products and solid sawn lumber. The SDW installs easily as the patented point ensures fast starts, reduced installation torque and eliminates the need for pre-drilling in most applications. The heat treated carbon steel, Black E-Coat Finish is currently stocked in a 6 3/4" length. The SDW enables single side fastening while still allowing concurrent loading on both sides of the assembly to the full allowable head or tip side load of the fastener. The low profile head allows for less interference after installation; makes stacking and sliding members easier and allows installation of hardware and finishes to be virtually flush. 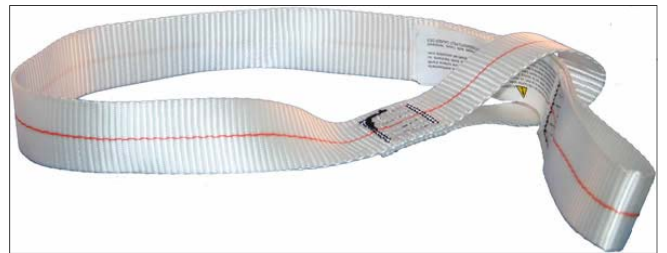
NEW OPERATIONAL HOURS

RESIDENTIAL ANCHOR SLINGS
