Grain Bags & Twine

These Agricultural products will **ONLY** be accepted at the **Coronation Transfer Site**.

Grain Bags

- Neatly rolled
- Securely tied with twine - use more than 1 twine wrap to secure
- Placed in the designated area

Twine

- Only clean polypropylene twine will be accepted
- Excessively dirty twine will not be accepted
- No fiber (sisel or jute twine), bale netting or nylon rope
- Collection bags should be translucent - plastic bags available from the transfer site attendant
- Bags of twine are to be placed in the designated area.

Easter Busy Bags for Seniors living alone in the Castor / Fleet / Halkirk / and west half of Paintearth County area are available through Castor & District FCSS.

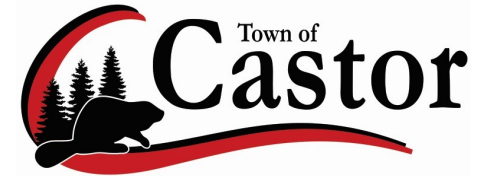
These are small gift bags with things to do in them. They will be delivered a few days before Good Friday if you live in Castor or Halkirk (please pick up at the town office otherwise).
