



# COUNCIL MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

## Public Hearing

A Public Hearing for Bylaw 2026-1110, to amend the land use Bylaw 1093, was held in conjunction with the regular meeting of Council. Bylaw 2026-1110 amends the definition of animal units and creates an additional Retreat definition under the Residential District uses. Further it amends Plan 1759 AE; Block X in the Town of Castor from Low Density Residential District to Residential Estates District.

Five (5) members of the Public spoke regarding the amendments, and four (4) written submissions were presented.

Bylaw 2026-1110 received first reading at a previous meeting of Council.

## Financial

Council accepted the budget update ending January 31, 2026, and the Gas and Water Reconciliations ending February 28, 2026.

The gas system is showing a 1.99% gain and the water system a loss of 16.16%. The figures presented were prior to the failure at the water distribution centre and the anticipated water loss in March will be substantially higher.

## April 13, 2026 Council Meeting

The Regular Meeting of Council scheduled for April 13, 2026 has been cancelled. The next upcoming meeting of Council will occur on April 27, 2026.

## Splash Park Update

A discussion occurred regarding the status of the Castor Splash Park. The Splash Park committee held a meeting on March 18, 2026 and has not secured grant funding for the project. At this time, Council has removed the splash park from the Capital Budget and disbanded the committee. Donated funds will be returned to the donors in the near future.

A request for the Residential Tax Incentive Program was approved for the property located at Plan 102 5348; Block 10; Lot 18.

## **Other**

Council approved a sponsorship request of \$200.00 for the 3C's U15F team who earned a berth to Provincials.

## **Bylaw 2026-1111**

Operational Borrowing Bylaw 2026-1111 was given three readings and passed. Operational Borrowing Bylaws are required yearly.
