To all members of the Kingston Area Taxi Commission:

The Chair reports and recommends as follows:

1. **That** the Kingston Area Taxi Commission amend the proposed Bylaw No.4, Section 5 and Section 9 as follows:

Bylaw 4, Section 5:

- a. Notwithstanding section 5, Brokers are exempt from reserve bookings where the number of licensed accessible taxicabs in operation at such brokerage is less than ten (10).

Bylaw 4, Section 9:

- a. Notwithstanding section 9, Brokers are exempt from reserve bookings where the number of licensed accessible taxicabs in operation at such brokerage is less than ten (10).

2. **That** the Kingston Area Taxi Commission amend the proposed Bylaw No.4, Section 16 as follows:

- a. Specific to accessible taxicabs only, the Taxi Fare charged to an Accessible Transit Client as detailed in section 16 shall be retained in full by the driver; and
- b. The total Taxi Fare charged shall be payable in accordance with the remuneration provisions of the Accessible Transit Pass agreements; and
- c. Where the number of licensed accessible taxicabs in operation at such brokerage is greater than ten (10), clause (a) and (b) shall be void.

3. **That** the Kingston Area Taxi Commission provide the initial AODA Certification of Accessible Plateholders and Drivers; and

That the Kingston Area Taxi Commission provide the initial Accessible Transit Pass program training to Brokers, Plateholders, and Drivers.
