ALL SAINTS DAY

The Solemnity of All Saints, celebrated annually on November 1st, is a day dedicated to the Saints of the Church, that is, all those who have attained heaven. It is a Holy Day of Obligation. Mass times are:

- Thursday, October 31st – All Saints Vigil Mass 6:00 pm @ St. Rose of Lima
- Friday, November 1st – All Saints Day: 7:00 am – St. John Ammannsville; 8:10 am – St. Rose of Lima; **5:30 pm – St. Mary High Hill**; 6:00 pm – St. Rose – Spanish.
