Currently, we are in need of volunteers to help prepare and serve lunch from about 10:00 am to 2:00 pm on those days.

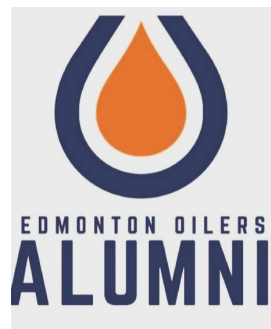
