

**BOARD OF SELECTMEN**  
**Meeting Minutes**

**August 26, 2019**

CALL TO ORDER: Sonny opened the meeting with the pledge at 7:05PM.

MINUTES:

- Wendy **motioned** to approve the minutes for August 19. Joanne **second**. **All** were in favor.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS:

- Mike Gilpatrick, Code Enforcement Officer, gave his July report. He also spoke of the importance of pool permits and also about how the Code Enforcement Office was going to be closed in the morning on August 27<sup>th</sup> and all day August 30<sup>th</sup>.
- Cindy Smith, Library Director, told everyone about some of the things that had happened in August and also some of the things that are going to be happening in September.
- Steve Malmude told everyone about the Poetry Workshop that he hosts.
- Judy LePage, Town Clerk, told the Board about the boxes of information in the basement for the CDBG grant for the Business Park.

OLD BUSINESS:

- The Board talked about the copiers in the Selectmen's Secretary's office and in the Town Clerk's office and decided that they would have to wait until March for the Town Meeting to be able to go into a longer than one year contract.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Snowplow contract, Sonny told everyone that only one bidder had bid the way that the Board had wanted it to be bid and that was R. C. Richardson for \$2,600 with the inclusion of sanding and hauling snow away when the snowbanks get to high. Joanne **motioned** to award the contract to R.C Richardson Jr. Wendy **second**. Gil made a comment about having the inclusion of hauling snow away being something that had been worked on. **Four** were in favor; **One** did not raise their hand. Joanne made the comment about having the Secretary send letters to the rest of the bidders.
- Dottie **motioned** to set the milrate at 15.75. Wendy **second**. **All** were in favor.
- The Board talked about the 2020 Block Party and how they were applying for a grant that needs the funds matched which could be taken out of the block party account. Joanne

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**motioned** to have Ann Colby present this grant, has to be in by September 1<sup>st</sup>, for \$500 for the Limerick Community Block Party 2020 Celebration. Dottie **second. All** were in favor.

- They discussed briefly the Clinical Affiliation Agreement for Jason Johnson, Fire Chief, and they decided to put it off for a week so everyone can read it.
- Joanne read the RSU 57 letter about buses and other vehicles and they discussed maybe they could use it for the Recreation Department but decided against it because they are not safe for children.
- The Board talked about the telephone contract and how it has doubled being with Consolidated Communications (FairPoint) and how there has been some problems with the Fire Department lines. The Board decided to check with Consolidated in order to see if we can get a better deal and if not check with Spectrum and see what they can offer us.
- Joanne brought up the Tax Map Index having some discrepancies and Dottie said that she needs to take care of that.

WARRANT:

- Wendy **motioned** to approve the warrant as written. Dottie **second. All** were in favor.

ANNOUNCEMENTS:

- Wendy read the announcements.

ADJOURN MEETING:

- Wendy **motioned** to adjourn. Dottie **second. All** were in favor.
- The Meeting was adjourned at 7:30PM.
