Answers each and every call.




We invite the bakers of our community to offer donations of Christmas themed baking.

Baking kindly received anytime from 12:30pm - 5 pm in the Hall on Friday, December 8.


Baking should be packaged ready to sell, preferably labelled what it is, and priced.

English hand smocked dresses for sale


