The Solemnity of All Saints, celebrated on November 1st, is a day dedicated to the Saints of the Church, that is, all those who have attained heaven. This is a Holy Day of Obligation. All Saints Vigil Mass times are St. Rose @ 6 PM, St. Mary/ High Hill @ 7 PM, St. Rose/Spanish @ 8 PM. All Saints Day Mass times are St. Rose @ 8:10 AM and 7 PM and St. Wenceslaus/Holman @ 7 PM.

November 2nd is the Feast of All Souls. Please see the schedule for the Mass times on this special day as we commemorate the faithfully departed. Each Mass will be held in the cemetery (weather permitting) and will be followed by the blessing of the graves.
