## 2020 Town of Stavely Fall Cleanup Program



Fall is here and the Town is proud to again offer our Fall Cleanup program. Every Tuesday for the month of October, Public Works will pick up general and construction waste in addition to regular garbage – items for this pick up may be set out on Mondays.

**Please Note** – every effort will be made to have non household garbage items picked up on the Tuesday but items may not be picked up until later in the week.

### Acceptable items:

- Furniture – couches, dressers, desks, chairs, tables.
- Appliances – dryers, washers, toasters, refrigerators, freezers, a/c units. (A fee will apply to any appliance containing Freon.)
- Metals
- "Other" or construction waste (should be no more than 75 lbs and no longer than 6' to accommodate the Town garbage truck)

### Non-Acceptable items:

Organic waste, toxic waste and electronics

Electronics are still accepted and can be placed in the bin located next to the recycling bin trailer. Tree branches and compostable material should be taken to the area east of Town near the lagoon. For toxic waste be sure to utilize the annual toxic waste roundup.

Please ensure all items set out for pick up are separated and are in neat piles next to your regular garbage. **NOTE:** If you are not sure if an item is approved to be picked up or if you have other general questions please contact the Town Office at 403-549-3761 or the Town Shop at 403-549-3944. STAVELY Library re-opened to the public on June 15th in response to Phase 2 guidelines. You will be able to:

- Check out books, dvd's audiobooks, cd's, magazines.
- You can pre-order your materials 3 ways: The preferred way is to place a HOLD in our catalogue. You can also send an email to [help@stavelylibrary.ca](mailto:help@stavelylibrary.ca). You may also call 403-549-2190 to order items
- All returns should be placed in the outside Book Drop. A 72-hour quarantine of returned materials is **necessary to comply with Provincial re-opening guidelines.**
- Two computers will be available to reserve.
- A hand sanitizer station is located at the front entrance. Please remember to use when entering or exiting the library. Hand sanitizer will also be available at the booked computer stations.
- Donations of new or used items to the library will be suspended until it is deemed safe to accept and process these items.
- Memberships: The library will be able to renew your library card or process new memberships during this phase.
- Public Washrooms will not be accessible to use for the time being. Masks are not required to enter the library but are encouraged.
- Food and drink in the library will not be permitted.
- Clear signage to maintain physical distancing regulations will be installed at the entrance and throughout the library. The number of people in the library will be limited to comply with Provincial regulations. If there is a line up at the front door, we ask you to please wait outside maintaining a 2-metre distance from others until it is clear to enter the library.

If you have any limitations or feel like you are not ready to re-enter the library at this time please call 403-549-2190 to schedule your pick up and your materials will be brought out to you.

We appreciate your patience during this transition time. We will be monitoring all provincial information and will move to the next Phase of re-opening as soon as it is deemed safe to do so.
