### **Principal Report:**

## **School Improvements**

EAs and teachers are in the school doing final year end preparations and cleanup of classrooms. Fresh coat of paint has been given and new office furniture is to be installed. Mrs. Germain has done some physical activity games on the pavement at the back of the school.

#### **Report Cards**

Report cards are being finalized and will be sent out by email to parents. Information about this will be sent out by Mrs. Lacey this week.

#### Staffing

There are two open teacher positions for next year: grade 5 and EEP. Anticipated classes for next year are as follow: EEP AM, EPP PM, K AM, K PM, 1, 1/2, 2, 3, 4, 4/5, 5, 6, 6. There will be a shakeup of which teachers are teaching the grades and we have a few staff members leaving and new teachers starting. Our school population is anticipated to remain around 250 but due to the higher number of students in the upper grades more classes were made to keep the class sizes smaller. As well, full day kindergarten is no longer offered.

### Grant

St Gabriel School has received some grant money to put towards an indoor tower garden and garden boxes. Installation will be done for the fall in preparation for the following year.

### **Offsite Learning**

District is to make an announcement in the next couple of days about offsite learning for the 2020-21 school year. The public school board has announced that they will be offering an E'cademy, full curriculum online learning, for 2020-21.


#### **OLD BUSINESS**

This encourages students to continue reading. Therefore, School Council will make a post on the Facebook group to encourage a book swap between parents. As well the RMWB library has a pickup and drop off service available on Tuesday and Thursdays so information about this will be posted on the Facebook group. Library membership can be done online and is free. Even though the Epic subscription from the school ends on June 30<sup>th</sup>, parents can still sign up for 1 month free. Additional months are \$7.99.

### **School Grounds Cleanup**

Sarah received a response on the guidelines for community cleanup this year and litter has started to accumulate on the school grounds again. A school grounds cleanup will be arranged for Thursday, June 25<sup>th</sup> at 10am. This way families can come participate in the school grounds cleanup right before the Year End Farewell bus loop drive thru. Social distancing and safety precautions will be taken, and garbage bags and gloves will be provided.
