

## **Meeting Summary for Taxi Commission 03-2024**

### **Quick recap**

The Kingston Area Taxi Commission held a meeting where they approved the agenda, a report from the Standing Committee, and commenced renovations to the Roy Ambury Memorial Room. They also reviewed and amended their bylaws, specifically Bylaw number 2, section 41.3, which regulates the process of renewal notices and suspension of taxi licenses, and Bylaw number 2, schedule F, to impose a monetary fee for the reinstatement of suspended taxi driver's licenses and taxi plates. These amendments were approved and will take effect from January 1, 2025.

### **Summary**

#### Taxi Commission Approves Renovations and Reports

The Kingston Area Taxi Commission held a meeting, with all commissioners present. The agenda was approved and no potential pecuniary interests were declared. The commission also approved a report from the Standing Committee, with Chappelle commending its comprehensiveness. A motion was passed to commence renovations to the Roy Ambury Memorial Room. Two motions were also approved as part of Report 003.

#### Taxi Commission Amends Bylaws

The Kingston Area Taxi Commission reviewed and amended their bylaws. Commissioner Dowser proposed to amend Bylaw number 2, section 41.3, which regulates the process of renewal notices and suspension of taxi licenses. The amended bylaw will send out notices of pending suspensions based on the year from the last unsuccessful renewals. The commission also decided to amend Bylaw number 2, schedule F, to impose a monetary fee for the reinstatement of suspended taxi driver's licenses and taxi plates. The

amendments were approved and will take effect from January 1, 2025. The minutes of the previous meeting were also confirmed.
