Summary of September's meeting

Jean-Marie Breault of Uponor gave a Power Point presentation about commercial applications of radiant cooling. Mr. Breault is an applications engineer with the Regina office of Uponor Ltd. He was accompanied by Mark Kenny a Moncton representative from Hydro-Mechanical Sales.

The principles of radiant heating and cooling were reviewed. A number of case studies of cooling systems were discussed, including several Scandinavian buildings and a new airport in Thailand. The new head office building of Manitoba Hydro, and the new Winnipeg airport were also presented. Some pertinent aspects of radiant cooling systems are:

- cooling loops are installed in floors
- best for large systems (not residential)
- can work effectively in buildings with high passive solar gains
- in tall atrium spaces, stratification of air is allowed, so that only the air in the first 3 metres above the floor need be cooled, while air temperatures at the ceiling can reach temperatures of 35° C or more




