## RESIDENTAL DEVELOPMENT INCENTIVE

## Did you Know:

The Town of Castor has a residential Development Incentive Byaw.

## What this Means:

New principal residential properties such as; new homes, duplexes, condominiums and apart nent buildings shall receive a municipal property tax reate on all land and buildings for ropoerties where dilapidated homes are demolished and replaced with new residential construction.

New principal residential properties such as; new homes, cuplexes, condomminiums and apart ent builidings shall received a municipal propetyy tax rebate on all lands and buil lings for ropoper fies where the lot was bare prior to construction.

## How itWorks:

Property owners must submita witten leter of application to the Town requesing the rebate rior to April 1 st of the tax year in which the ereate shal beapplied.

Tax reates shal be approved by a resolution of the Town Council not tater than May 31 lst t each year.

The Tax rebates shall be paplied to the property tax account prior to tax notices being sent out. Rebate Calculation:

The rebate shal be eapplied to the muncicipal portion of the annual tex levy only, and shall be alculated asfolows:
A. The assessment value for the propetty improvements shall be frozen for a three year period following completion of the new construction.
B. The reate of the difference between the annual municipal tax lev calculated at the current years' assessed value and the muncicipal tax lery calculated at the "frozen" assessment rate shall be applied to the tax roll of the oulalifing prooenty
C. The "frozen" assessment rate shall be the a asessed value of improvements on the propety y the tax year immediately prior to demolition of the previous structure
D. School, Senior Lodge, RCMP and other institutions property taxes are excluded from any reduction in overall property taxes.
E. Properties shall pay any school recuisition calculted separately from the "froezn" ascesmentr tates.
