

BOARD OF SELECTMEN MEETING

July 5, 2016

MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

SELECTMEN IN ATTENDANCE:

CALL TO ORDER:

- Sonny called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Welcome to the viewing audience and flag salute.

MINUTES:

- Selectman Andrews **made a motion** to accept the Highlights of June 27, 2016 as written. Chairman LePage **seconded** the motion. Selectman Medici asked for one change to be made on a vote and **made a motion** to accept the Highlights with one change. Selectman Andrews **seconded**. All were in favor.

SCHEDULED SPEAKERS:

- Vicki Carroll informed the Board about a new committee that has been formed to work on having a Veteran's Memorial in Tibbett's Park. She would like to have several committees down the road for fundraising, citizens able to do physical work at the park, and a group to investigate costs of a memorial stone or stones. Selectman Medici **made a motion** to allow the formation of a Tibbett's Memorial Park Revitalization Sub-Committee consisting of up to eleven (11) members. Selectman Andrews **made the second**. All were in favor.
- Del Floyd from the Historical Society was asking about progress on repairs at the Moore Building. Chairman LePage stated that Rick Nugent, the Town Custodian, will do the necessary painting and he will begin on the rear of the building. S & S Services will be contacted to give an estimate.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS:

- Ron Phinney gave his report on permits for the month of June.
- Joanne Andrews told about a husband and wife who heard the segment regarding the town beach and they went down to check it out and found it loaded with dog feces. No dogs are allowed.

- Selectman Andrews passed along a complaint from a resident regarding people speaking from the audience without going to the podium and that it is difficult to hear conversations.
- Bob Richardson said that he is making good progress on the paving projects.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Warrant Articles could not be written as the Board of Selectmen did not have all the figures needed.
- Wording for Warrant Article for matching funds was read by Selectman Andrews.
- Selectman Medici will have the quote from the engineer at next week's meeting.
- Michael Connolly thanked the Board for coming to his property to look at the necessary work to be done on the cemetery. Selectman Medici **made a motion** that the work to be done was maintenance and not construction. Joanne Andrews **seconded**. All were in favor.
- Selectman Andrews thanked Frank Carroll, Sr. for helping at the Connolly property and for all the work he and his crew have done to the cemetery located on Enterprise Road.
- Chairman LePage thanked the Provencher family for weed whacking multiple times at the Highland Cemetery. Selectman Medici **made a motion** to spend up to \$11,000.00 for Sterling Lawn Control to spray weeds along the roadway and the cemetery. Chairman LePage **seconded**. All were in favor.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Chairman LePage read the Thank You letter from York County Community Action thanking the townspeople for the money raised at Town Meeting to support their organization.
- John Medici would like a letter sent to the Fire Department to have them register the ATV and it's trailer to the Town of Limerick so both items can be properly insured.

- John read the Announcements.

WARRANTS:

- **Motion made** by Chairman to accept the warrants. Selectman Andrews **made the second**. All were in favor.

HEARING OF CITIZENS:

- Denise Benton asked if the Budget Committee needed to meet to discuss the upcoming financial expenditures. Chairman LePage told her they could meet, but would have to be timely so there are no further delays.

MEETING ADJOUNED:
