ALL INFORMATION SLIPS

Please provide all your T4s and income slips to avoid a 20% penalty from CRA. Moving expenses (if you moved more than 40kms closer to work and had or will have income after

Provide receipts for eligible the move) school/classroom supplies (up to \$1000) and a letter from your employer confirming the supplies were for use in the classroom. ☐ Union or professional dues paid that are not on your T4 slip ☐ Interest on student loans (only provincial/federal student loans qualify) ☐ Home office expenses. You may be eligible to claim home office expenses if you worked from home ☐ Child care expenses paid, only if incurred when you went to work 50% or more of the time over a consecutive 4 week period. Adoption related expenses ☐ First time home buyers' tax credit. If you purchased your first home, provide legal/lawyer ☐ Clergy residence deduction information (provide a signed form T1223) documentation of the purchase.* *If you paid GST on your home purchase or build, you may be eligible to receive some of your GST back. Provide details of cash, stocks, trusts, real estate, etc. ☐ Provide utility bills, rent receipts, or property tax bills (required even if only claiming travel). $\hfill \Box$ Disability Tax Credit. If you or a family member qualify, provide form T2201 signed by a doctor If you are using utility bills or rent receipts, provide one from January and one from (blank forms can be picked up at our office). Note that it can take a long time to be approved and you can only claim the credit after approval. Eligible diseases/conditions include diabetes, cystic fibrosis, kidney dialysis, down syndrome, blindness, confinement to wheelchair, mental disabilities, ☐ For travel claims, also provide receipts for fuel, hotels, campground or parking fees, meals, etc. Credit card or bank statements are acceptable if they show the city of purchase. ☐ Children in the household claiming a portion of the northern residence or travel need a letter ☐ Charity donation/contribution receipts (must be a registered charity). Even small donations can signed by a parent (letter can be picked up at our office prior to appointment) and a copy of have a significant benefit.
