Please be advised the 2021 Property Tax Notices have been mailed May 10, 2021. The deadline for payment is July 31, 2021. Balances owing after July 31, 2021 will be subject to a 15% penalty August 1, 2021 and a further 15% penalty applied on all outstanding balances January 1, 2022.
