

# Lund Seafood Festival

## Food Vendor Contract

May 14 & 15 2022



### Terms

Food Vendor Sites are assigned on a first-paid-first-choice basis. A Food Vendor Site costs \$25.00 plus 50¢ per ticketed serving. Please bring your own booth supplies; cookware, tent, signs, plates, napkins, ice, etc. Electricity is not provided.

Food Vending hours are promptly 12noon–4pm and you must sell at least one type of seafood. Be prepared to provide at least 200 appy-size servings each day. Small portions encourage people to sample more food at more booths.


Vendors are responsible for their own Food Safe Permit and Hand Washing Station. Vehicles are not permitted within the Festival area but supplies can be replenished from behind the Vendor's site.

Food Tickets are sold at the Food Tickets Booth for \$6.00 each. Upon presentation of one Food Ticket, the Vendor serves the customer one portion of food. Finger-food is preferred. It is not permitted to request multiple tickets for one portion.

Cash sales are not permitted. Collect Food Tickets in a large container labelled with your Vendor name. At the close of each day, take your container of tickets to the Food Tickets Booth to be tallied. Each Food Vendor will receive \$5.50 cash per ticket.

The Lund Seafood Festival is a **zero-waste event**. While at this Festival, you will be responsible for your own garbage/waste.

You will receive an email confirmation with your Vendor Site number. Deposits are non-refundable but are transferrable to a different Vendor.
