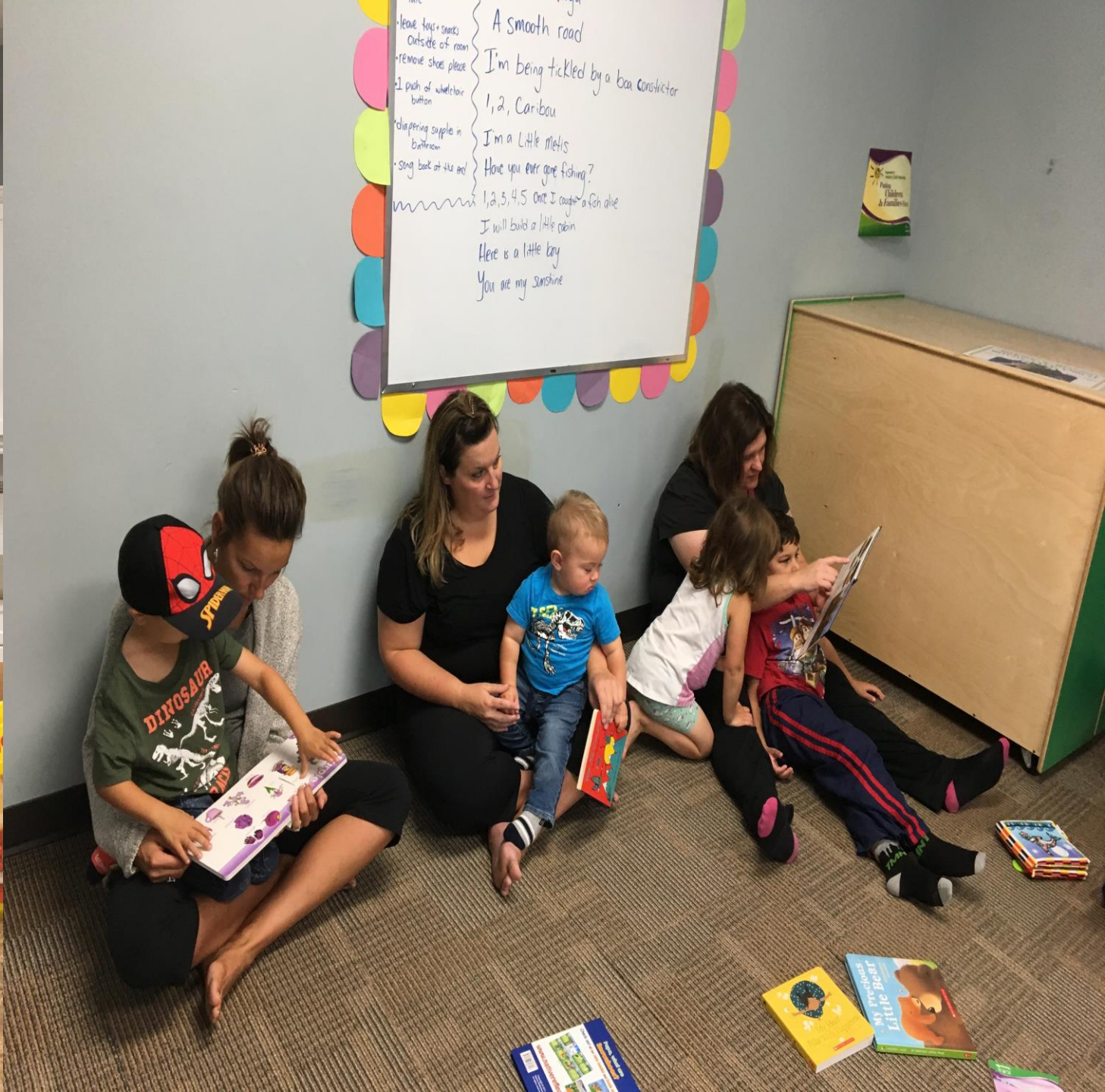


## Little Metis Sing With Me

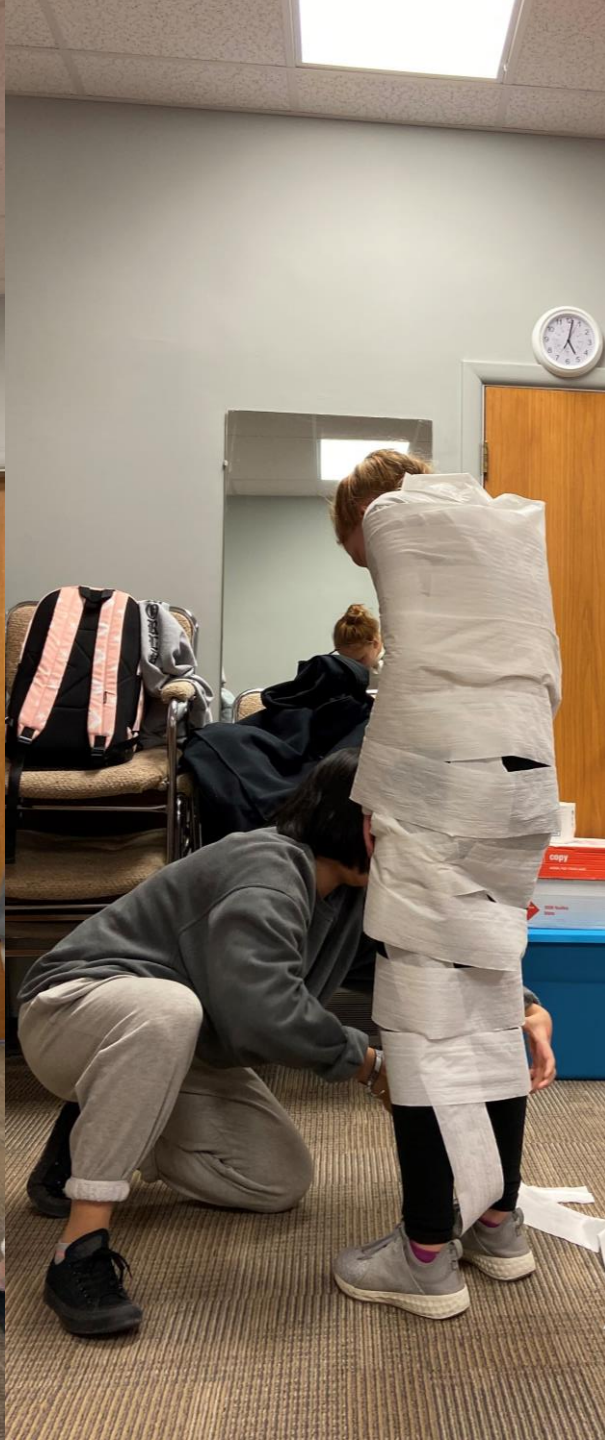
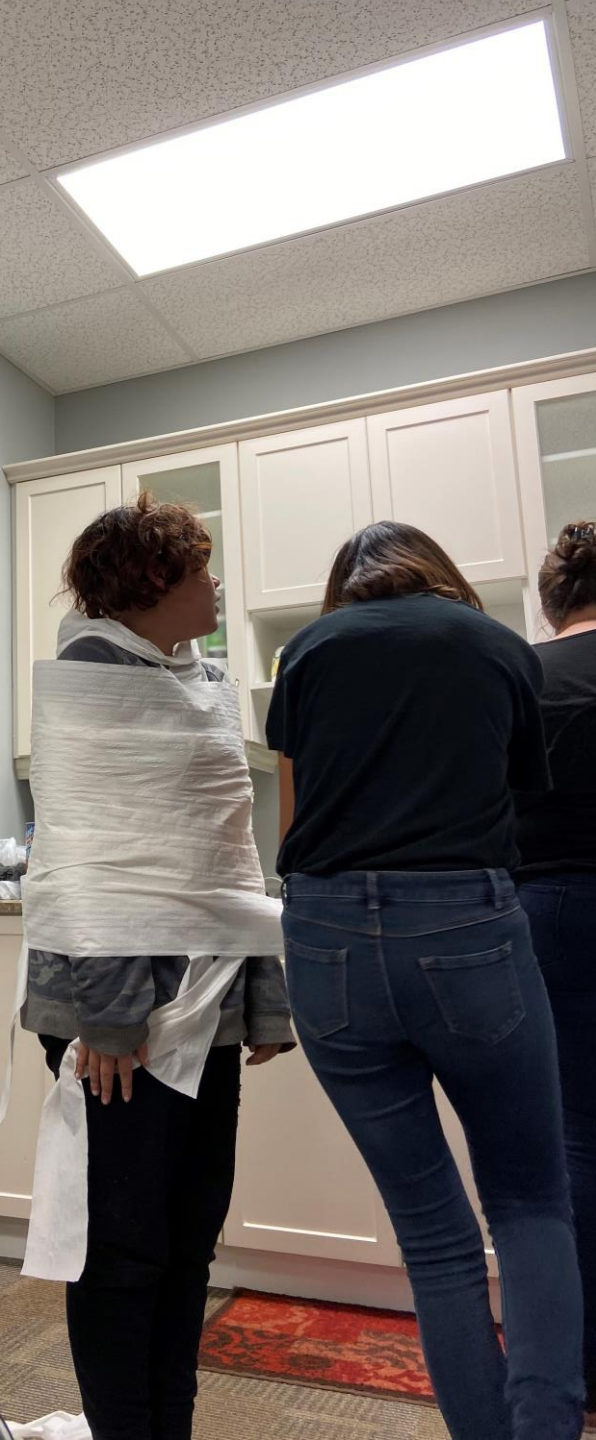
