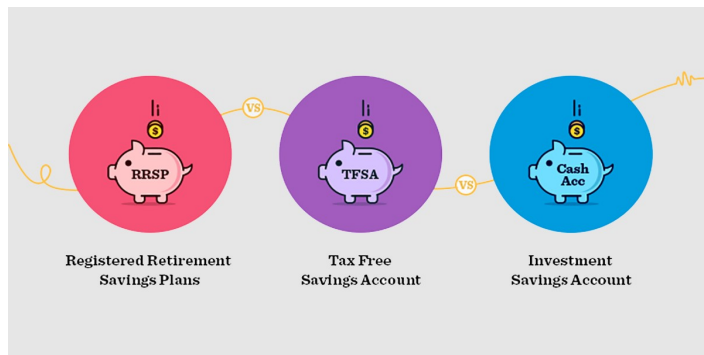

### Town News

**Dog Licenses:** As per the Town's animal control bylaw all dogs over 3 months of age are required to be licensed on an annual basis. The fees payable starting February 1st are \$30.00 for each sterilized dog or \$45.00 for each non-sterilized dog. Please remember to stop in at the Town Office and get your 2019 dog license. Penalties can be issued for having a non-licensed dog.

**Business Licenses:** Business Licenses are also due. In Town \$30.00, Home Occupations \$45.00. Please come in and renew your license as soon as possible.
