**Whereas** upon agreement with Industry Stakeholders, these new Taxi Plates are to be affixed to all taxicabs by September 30, 2022;

**Therefore** be it resolved that effective October 31, 2022, the new taxi plate design be the only approved Taxi Plate, and that any other taxi plate including metal plates be deemed invalid, and;

Taxicabs that do not have the new Taxi Plate and validation tag affixed to the vehicle bumper shall be deemed to be non-compliant and shall be subject to enforcement.

**Whereas** the Kingston Area Taxi Commission has an established By-Law which governs the licensing and regulation specific to Accessible Taxis;
