Sunday, September 29, is recognized in the United Church of Canada as

Truth and Reconciliation Sunday.

We invite everyone to wear orange to worship on that Sunday as we come together in the spirit of hope and reconciliation.

On Orange Shirt Day, Honour and Remember Indigenous Children Who **Attended Residential Schools**

On September 30, people all across Canada will wear orange shirts to remember and honour Indigenous children who were taken from their communities and families to residential institutions.

On Orange Shirt Day we also observe the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation. For non-Indigenous Christians in particular, this is a time to reflect on their role in colonialism and the ongoing responsibility to make reparations. It is a time for us all to remember those events and their ongoing impact. Visit the United Church website, and learn about the many ways to mark the day between September 22-30.

We will also recognize British Home Child Day on Sunday, September 29.

An often forgotten part of Canada's history is being recognized on Saturday, September 28 marking British Home Child Day.

The migration scheme saw more than 100,000 children sent from Britain to Canada between 1869 and the 1930s. Most of the children weren't orphaned, but were from families living in poverty. They were sent from Great Britain to Canada, where it was believed they'd have a better life and opportunities. The majority of them became domestic servants and labourers. Some were sexually, psychologically or physically abused.

John Adams, a historian and author will be speaking at our September 24th meeting, 1:30 p.m. In the Sanctuary. The topic will be ghosts and spooky stories, appropriate as Halloween approaches. Honouring the Legacy of Trailblazer Lois Wilson

With great sadness, The United Church of Canada announces the death of The Very Rev., The Honourable Dr. Lois M. Wilson, the denomination's 28th Moderator, and the first woman to fill the role. She faithfully served as Moderator from 1980 to 1982. The Rev. Wilson died in hospital in Fredericton, NB, on Sept. 13, 2024. She was 97 years old.
