

Summary of April Meeting

We were privileged to have two outstanding presentations by ASHRAE distinguished lecturer, Victor Goldschmidt. Twenty-five people attended the regular meeting and heard Victor's take on *Sustainability in the Context of Power Plants*. We also welcomed David Rasmussen, Regional Vice-Chair for Resource Promotion. The next afternoon, Victor led a lively interactive workshop on *Problem Solving and Creativity* for 19 people at NBCC Moncton. We were pleased to welcome members of the Moncton Branch of APEGNB to both sessions, and Doug Scott and students from NBCC Saint John on Wednesday.

On Tuesday evening, Victor reviewed ASHRAE's mission statement and core values while exploring various definitions of "sustainability". He considered the three sectors of "stability" – environment, social and environment. Sustainability is met when these three sectors overlap. He compared installed costs of various "sustainable" energy systems, using data from EPRI.

He concluded that wind and solar PV generation proposals must consider capacity factors **and** the need for some backup power as well.






