DIRECTIONS TO THE HOOLEY™

Take the New York State Thruway to Exit 19 (Kingston). You will be exiting the toll booth onto the Kingston Roundabout. Take the second exit from the Roundabout for Washington Avenue. Proceed on Washington Avenue.

There will be signs directing you to parking venues. The City and the AOH have arranged several parking venues for the "Hooley™" that are clearly marked. Free shuttle buses will be provided to the Hooley™ site at the Rondout in Kingston.

Parking venues are: The Kingston Plaza, the Cornell Street public lot and Kingston Point. Handicap Parking will be available at Kingston Point
