



# COUNCIL MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

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## Delegation

Sgt. J. Houle presented the 2025 third quarter Crime Stats for the area. The RCMP is modernizing and strengthening the way they partner with communities to address local public safety needs and will be engaging with community representatives throughout the year.

## Tax Penalty Relief

A request for tax penalty relief was received. The request was denied and there were no changes to the tax arrears.

## Candy Crush Tournament

Council received a recommendation from Castor Recreation Board that the tournament fees for the Candy Crush Softball Tournament be set at five hundred dollars (\$500.00) per team, and the fees for participating Castor teams be waived. The recommendation was moved and passed.

## Quality Management Plan

The Quality Management Plan was reviewed and adopted by Council. The Quality Management Plan is an agreement with the Province and is required to maintain the Town of Castor's 'Approval to Operate' license for the gas system.

## Other

Council elected to list for sale the property located at Plan 8387 T; Block 4; Lot 5.

The Administrative Assistant was appointed to the Castor Halkirk Community Van Society for a period of one year.

The Castor Golf Club Stay-n-Play Camping and Golf Marketing program was tabled to a future meeting of Council.

The Castor and District Family and Community Support Services will see a reduction of rent in the amount of six hundred dollars (\$600.00) for the 2026 year.

Closed Sessions will see the addition of a plain language description of the topic to be discussed at the discretion of the CAO.
