Garbage

To ensure your garbage is picked up every week, please have it set out by 7:00 am. All garbage needs to be bagged as it is not the towns responsibility to pick up lose garbage that has been spread by critters. Placing your garbage bags in a bin also prevents it from being spread all over.

Each household is allowed a maximum of 5 bags of garbage with a maximum weight of 40 lbs per bag each week. Anything above that will be left behind.

The following is a list of items that will also not be picked up, but should be taken to the waste transfer station and placed in the proper area:

- Construction materials
- Furniture
- Electronics
- Refrigerators, stoves, dishwashers, hot water tanks
- Oils, paints and other liquids
- Dead animal carcasses
- Branches / debris that is not bundled or bagged
- Ashes
- Loose garbage thrown in barrels /drums


