Summary of September's Meeting

Over 30 people attended the first meeting of the new year, including a good number of students from l'Université de Moncton and the New Brunswick Community College.

The speaker was Paul Aresnault of AlternaHOME Solutions, who described the sustainable home being built in Moncton. A joint venture between the Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation, VISION Land Development and AlternaHOME, this demonstration home is one of only three in Canada currently in the design build phase under CMHC's "Equilibrium Initiative".

The steps in this project include: (1) Evaluation; (2) Concept; (3) Design, (4) Construction, (5) Standards, (6) Documentation, (7) Certification. Renewable energy strategies include: (1) (2) (3) (4)

The home is projected to be "net-zero" in yearly energy consumption, with excess kWh generated used to offset energy purchased from the power utility at other times.



High-Performance Building Standard 189.1

Proposed Standard 189.1, Standard for the Design of High Performance, Green Buildings Except Low-Rise Residential Buildings, is being developed by the American Society of Heating, Refrigerating and Air-Conditioning Engineers (ASHRAE) in conjunction with the Illuminating Engineering Society (IES) and the U.S. Green Building Council (USGBC). The standard is slated to be the first code-intended commercial green building standard in the United States. It is expected to be published in early 2010.
