- 1. Division Rules & Regulations & scoring will follow the <u>BC 4-H Guidelines</u> for the applicable 4-H Projects
- 2. Classes will be scheduled upon receiving all entries in order to determine age category and unit class sizes.
- 3. Projects may be sold through the Provincial Winter Fair Livestock Auction on the Monday of the Fair at a 6% commission to the Provincial Winter Fair Note for Buyers: **(Payable GST is applicable on the auction price)
 - a. Members have until **NOON on FRIDAY** of the Fair to inform the PWF Office that they wish to sell their Project through the PWF Livestock Auction. Members must be present on Sale Day in the ring with their project in order to sell it.
- 4. Photography Projects sold through the PWF Livestock Auction must be framed.
- 5. The maximum size of sale photographs must not exceed 600 square inches.
- 6. Members are permitted to edit their photos using a software as it showcases their talent. Leaders are to ensure members are performing the editing duties.
- 7. Photography members will have 1 entire table for their display unless #members exceed the display area. Members are to showcase their 10-15 photos, portion of their record book that relates to their photos, plus their framed sale portrait.
