

BOARD OF SELECTMEN
Meeting Highlights

July 09, 2018

CALL TO ORDER: Sonny opened the Meeting at 7:00 PM with the flag salute.

SELECTMEN IN ATTENDANCE:

DEPARTMENT REPORTS:

- Joanne Andrews – Transfer Station, Joanne reported that they had to stop taking household waste and recycling due to an overload of trash dropped off at the Transfer Station. Joanne stated that many people had to be turn away over on Sunday, and they stated that they were not aware that the town provided door to door pick up.
- Mike Gilpatrick – Code Enforcement Officer. Mike read his report for the month of June.
- Mike Gilpatrick – Water and Sewer Department, Mike stated that this month they will start the Sludge Removal Process at the Lagoons.
The new product (SeaQuest) that was purchased for Water treatment has not been implemented as of yet because they needed to make some changes that they were unaware of. The Drinking Water Program requested that they purchase over eight hundred dollars' worth of testing equipment in order to be sure they are testing the water accurately. The new water testing process should be up and running by the end of the month.
- Lisa LePage – Parks & Rec, Lisa updated the board on the many activities going on with Parks and Rec department, Tumbling, Swimming, soccer etc... Signs are up at the parks, parks are closed from 9:00 PM – 7:00 AM.
Lisa reported that the wharf at the lake is missing again. Lisa wanted to know if we should build a new one.
 - **Selectman LePage suggested finding the old wharf before building a new one.**
- Lisa discussed purchasing new soccer goals for the field out of the parks and recs budget and then replacing the cost with money raised through some sort of fund raising effort. Lisa stated that she has the funds to clear more land this year but she won't be able to seed or irrigate until next year.
 - **The selectmen stated that buying goals now is too soon and she should wait until next year to purchase new goals.**
 - **Selectman Andrews asked if Lisa has noticed a tree killed by woodpeckers. Lisa stated she would look for it.**

- DEP does not allow sand to be brought in to make beaches.

 - **Mike stated that a web-site and auto pay is his goal.**

 - **Selectman Andrews made a motion that the board advertise the Washington Street snow removal for one year. Selectman Thorne seconded the motion. The vote passed 5-0.**
