

Sub-Committees

Fundraising

Fundraising Committee:

- Will consist of a minimum of 2 others and a max of 4, not including the fundraising coordinator.
- The fundraising committee will assign 2 money handlers at each fundraiser.
- All monies must be counted with 2 people present. Fundraising coordinator will do the final count.
- Must use the required money forms provided by the society.
- Identify and communicate with coordinator about potential business partners, coordinator may ask you to approach them as well.

Fundraising Coordinator:

- Will lead the planning and management of fundraising events.
- Will communicate and work together as a team with all people on the fundraising committee.
- Will work with the team to prospect and solicit major donors.
- Identify and approach potential business partners.
- Help increase communication with supporters.
- Will assist with general fundraising activities as needed.
- Will prepare and deliver reports at the monthly meetings.

Travel / Festival

Travel / Festival Committee:

- Work together to plan and establish activities throughout the year, both at festivals and at home.

Travel / Festival Coordinator:

- Is responsible for booking blocks for festival hotels.
- Will communicate and work together as a team with all people on the travel / festival committee.
- Will prepare and deliver reports at the monthly meetings.

Apparel

Apparel Committee:

- Will consist of a minimum of 2 others and a max of 4, not including the apparel coordinator.
- Will organize sizing nights.

Apparel Coordinator:

- Will communicate and work together as a team with all people on the apparel committee.
- Will lead the planning and purchasing of apparel.
- Will prepare and deliver reports at the monthly meetings.

Den Mothers

- Each dance group will have one chosen parent or guardian be the representative for that group.
