ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for the 2024 Crushing Project will be received by Twin Falls Highway District, 2620 Kimberly Road, Twin Falls, Idaho 83301 until 1:00 P.M. local time on Wednesday, November 6, 2024, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud at 1:15 P.M. at the Twin Falls Highway District bi-monthly meeting.

The project consists of providing 50,000 TONS - ½" cover coat material and 30,000 TONS - ½" crushed aggregate in accordance with bid. It is the intent of these documents to describe the work required to complete this project in sufficient detail to secure comparable bids. All parts or work not specifically mentioned which are necessary in order to provide a complete installation shall be included in the bid and shall conform to all Local, State and Federal requirements.

There will be a non-mandatory onsite pre-bid meeting at the Goat Springs site, 12:00 PM noon-4:00 PM on Tuesday, October 29, 2024.

The work performed under this contract shall be complete in its entirety on or before March 15, 2025.

There are no Federal funds utilized in this project.
