

For the April meeting of our church's book club, the "Bookies" were asked to each choose a book from our church library, read it, and share their impressions with the group. We had a very good get-together and realized how much there is to explore in our very own library. We want to share some recommended books with other readers in our congregation:

**FIC** Baking Cakes in Kigali by G. Parkin

Par A charming and funny novel set in modern Rwanda about the true meaning of reconciliation, how people find a way to celebrate life. Angel Tungaraza bakes 14 confections and shares the story behind each one.

**FIC** Wish You Were Here by Jody Picoult

Pic Goodreads Nominee for Best Fiction 2022. Described as "a moving novel about the resilience of the human spirit in a moment of crisis." The story moves from a planned life Sotheby's auction house to an unplanned existence on the Galapagos during the pandemic.

**FIC** Shipping News by Annie Proulx

Pro Winner of a Pulitzer Prize is a "vigorous, darkly comic and at times magical portrait of the contemporary No. American family, after a tragedy, to their family home in Newfoundland"

FIC The Little Old Lady Who Broke All The Rules by Katrina Sundberg

A guirky and humorous story of 79 year-old woman who does not want to go guietly into old Sun age. She and her "League of Pensioners" challenge the restrictions of their retirement home and move on to more daring exploits.

All are welcome even if you just want to sit and enjoy the outdoors. Carpooling from the church is an option.


# Update on Ukrainian Families in Cordova Bay

Kelly Insley has given us the following update:

A new Ukrainian family has arrived in Cordova Bay. They are presently staying temporarily with a host family on Mysty Road. The father, Alex, worked in construction in Ukraine, and he is currently working for the host family. The mother, Iryna, was an accountant in agriculture in Ukraine. They have a young boy, Kyle, who is four years old.

The family that we helped out a year ago, Lesia, Mika, and Grandma, will have to move to a new home soon, as the house on Cordova Bay Road owned by Tetyana where they presently live will be going up for sale.

There has been some discussion of the two families getting together and trying to find a house to rent. In addition, the families need one small scooter, one small two-wheeler bike with training wheels, and one adult bike.
