

FIC Par	<u>Baking Cakes in Kigali</u> by G. Parkin A charming and funny novel set in modern Rwanda about the true meaning of reconciliation, how people find a way to celebrate life. Angel Tungaraza bakes 14 confections and shares the story behind each one.
FIC Pic	<u>Wish You Were Here</u> by Jody Picoult Goodreads Nominee for Best Fiction 2022. Described as "a moving novel about the resilience of the human spirit in a moment of crisis." The story moves from a planned life at Sotheby's auction house to an unplanned existence on the Galapagos during the pandemic.
FIC Pro	Shipping News by Annie Proulx Winner of a Pulitzer Prize is a "vigorous, darkly comic and at times magical portrait of the contemporary No. American family, after a tragedy, to their family home in Newfoundland"
FIC Sun	<u>The Little Old Lady Who Broke All The Rules</u> by Katrina Sundberg A quirky and humorous story of 79 year-old woman who does not want to go quietly into old age. She and her "League of Pensioners" challenge the restrictions of their retirement home and move on to more daring exploits.
242.4 Hol	And God Said, Let There Be Laughter by Mary Hollingsworth "Humorous and inspiring stories, quotes, and quips."
283 Tay	<u>Altars in the World</u> by Barbara Brown Taylor A book about everyday practices for people to feel more fully human, more spiritually connected to God. An engaging and enlightening book that can be read as a devotional, giving the reader time to read and think about each practice.
378.1 Alb	<u>Tuesdays With Morrie</u> by Mitch Albom A powerful true story of the author's visits with his dying mentor and college sociology professor. Morrie shares the most important lessons he learned in life and his thoughts during his last days.
