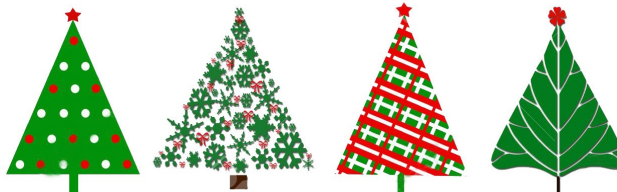

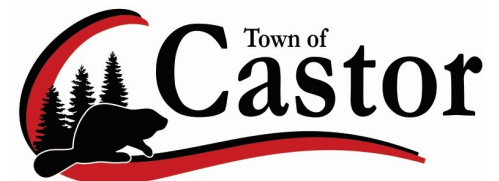

CHRISTMAS STAR

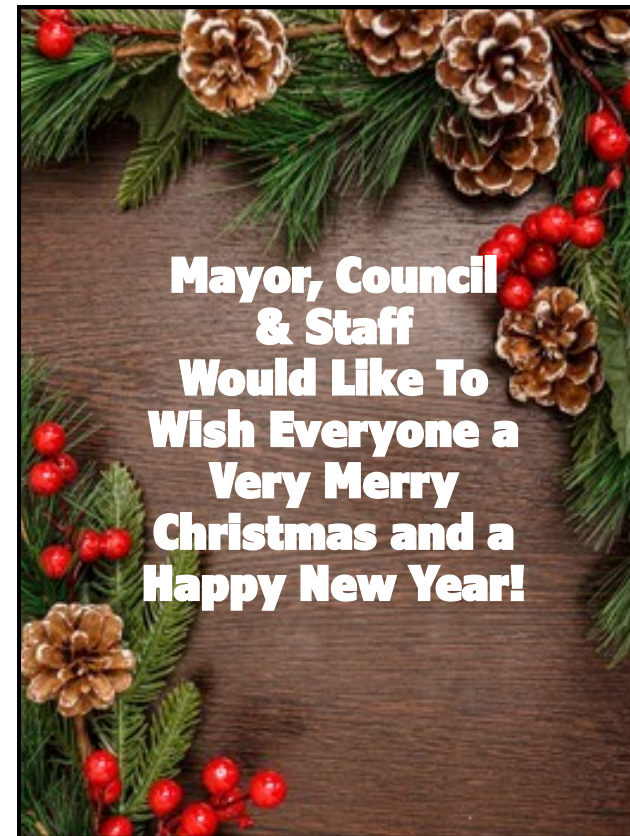
A diamond shines no brighter
