## Household Hazardous Waste Roundup

The Household Hazardous Waste Roundup has a new confirmed date and will be held on **September 12<sup>th</sup>, 2020**. We do have physical distancing in place for Covid-19. Please watch for bulletins and newspaper as a reminder of date and times of each location.

### Agricultural Plastics and Recycling

All chemical jugs can be dropped off at Castor or Coronation locations. Please rinse **three times and remove cap and label** off jug prior coming to site. Any cardboard boxes can be flattened and placed in Cardboard Recycling Bin. **Extreme amount of time is spent on this because of neglect by others.**

### Expanded Electronics Recycling Pilot

Province has approved a two year pilot project that we will be implementing at all three Transfer Stations. The details need to be worked out but, some examples are, audio visual equipment, small home appliances, portable power tools, toys and solar panels. There will be no cost to consumers to recycle the additional products. Stay tune for dates when additional recycling will start.
