#### HEALTH POLICIES

Children who are ill must not be sent to the facility. A child who has any of the following symptoms must be kept home, and if they develop these symptoms while in our care, parents will be contacted to pick up their child.

TEMPERATURE OVER 100F

VOMITING

DIARRHEA

DISCHARGE

RED ITCHY EYES

SWOLLEN GLANDS

HEAD LICE

OTHER CHILDHOOD ALIMENTS

(chicken pox, mumps, measles etc. )

RUNNY NOSE with yellow/green

UNDIAGNOSED RASH

SORE THROAT

COUGH

If your child comes down with these symptoms while in our care, we will try to contact you at you at work/home/cellphone for immediate pick up. If we are unable to contact you, we will contact your emergency contact person.

Children must be free of any symptoms for 24 hours before returning to our facility.

\*\*\* Please inform your child's supervisor of all illnesses your child comes down with, so that we can notify other parents to watch for symptoms\*\*\*

#### **COVID 19 POLICIES**

CHILDREN AND STAFF UPON ARRIVAL TO KCKC WILL BE MET AT THE DOOR. THEY WILL HAVE THEIR TEMPERATURES CHECKED. THEY WILL ALSO BE ASKED THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS.

1. HAVE YOU RECENTLY TRAVELLED OUTSIDE OF THE COUNTRY OR PROVINCE? IF YES HAVE DONE THE 14 DAY SELF ISOLATION?
2. DOES YOUR CHILD HAVE ANY COVID 19, INFLUENZA OR COMMON COLD SYMPTONS?
3. HAVE YOU TRAVELLED TO ANY PROVINCE COVID -19 HOT SPOTS OR HAD ANY GATHERINGS WITH MORE THEN 10 PEOPLE?
4. HAVE YOU OR YOUR CHILD BEEN IN CONTACT WITH ANYONE WHO HAS TESTED POSITIVE FOR COVID -19?

#### **DAILY COVID 19 POLICES**

1. ONCE IN THE BUILDING THE CHILDREN AND STAFF WILL BE ASKED TO WASH THEIR HANDS WITH SOAP AND WARM WATER FOR A MINIMUM OF 20 SECONDS.
2. ONCE IN THE CENTRE TABLES WILL BE LIMITED TO 2 CHILDREN PER TABLE ONE AT EACH END DURING MEALS, CRAFTS AND PLAY.
3. TABLES WILL BE CLEANED BEFORE AND AFTER CRAFTS, SNACK AND LUNCH AND AT THE END OF EACH DAY.
4. HIGH VOLUME PLAY TOYS WILL BE SANITIZED AFTER USE WITH A SOLUTION OF BLEACH AND WATER.
5. MATTS USED FOR QUIET TIME OR PLAY WILL BE CLEANED AFTER EACH USE WITH BLEACH AND WATER
6. LIGHT SWITCHES DOOR HANDLES WILL BE CLEANED TWICE A DAY.
7. CHILDREN AND STAFF WILL BE ASKED TO WASH THEIR HANDS IF THEY TOUCH THEIR FACES.
8. CHILDREN AND STAFF WILL WASH THEIR HANDS BEFORE AND AFTER EATING SNACK AND LUNCH AFTER PLAYING OUTSIDE, TOUCHING THEIR FACES OR BLOWING THEIR NOSES.
9. WEATHER PERMITTING MOST OF OUR PROGRAMING WILL BE DONE OUTSIDE GIVING THE CHILDREN MORE ROOM TO RUN AND PLAY.
10. CHILDREN WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO TOUCH OTHERS OR THEIR BELONGINGS.
11. CUBBIES WILL BE SANITIZED DAILY
12. DURING DROP OFF AND PICK UP KCKC STAFF WILL SIGN THE CHILDREN IN AND OUT PARENTS WILL BE MET AT THE DOOR.
13. STUFFED TOYS HAVE BEEN SANITIZED AND PUT AWAY FOR NOW.
14. TOYS AND CRAFT SUPPLIES ON THE FLOOR AT ONE TIME HAVE BEEN DOWN SIZED AND ARE SANITIZED ON A REGULAR BASIS.

15. DOORS AND WINDOWS ARE BEING LEFT OPEN WEATHER PERMITTING DURING THE DAY FOR OPTIMAL AIR FLOW.
16. CHILDREN WHILE OUTSIDE HAVE NOT BEEN PLAYING ON ANY PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT. ONCE PLAYGROUNDS OPEN THE CHILDREN WILL PRACTICE SOCIAL DISTENSING ON THE EQUIPMENT AND THEN WASH THEIR HANDS AFTER USE

#### **TRANSPORTATION TO AND FROM SCHOOL ON OUR BUS**

1. SIBLINGS SIT TOGETHER ON THE BUS.
2. WINDOWS ON THE BUS WILL BE LEFT OPEN FOR OPTIMAL AIR FLOW.
3. ONCE THE CHILDREN AND STAFF EXIT THE BUS THE SEATS RAILINGS AND HANDLES WILL BE SANITIZED BEFORE THE NEXT RUN.
4. OUR BUS DRIVER WILL WEAR PERSONAL PROTECTION GEAR. UPON ARRIVAL OF WORK THE DRIVER WILL WASH HANDS AND HAVE THEIR TEMPERATURE AND SYMPTONS CHECKED.
5. ONCE ALL BUS RUNS ARE COMPLETE THE BUS WILL BE COMPLETED SANITIZED AND WIPED DOWN.

**When children are taking the bus to and from school. They will be washing their hands before entering the bus from Kckc. When the bus picks them up from school, they will be asked to use hand sanitizer before getting on the bus. While on the bus we will have siblings sitting together and if possible, have every second seat occupied. Kool Cats students and staff who do ride the bus will be provided with a mask to wear while on the bus. If you wish to provide a mask for child that is fine if not, we will supply them with one and they will remain on the bus and be cleaned on a regular basis.**

**CHILDREN AND STAFF WHO ARE SICK AND SHOW ANY SYMPTONS WILL BE EXPECTED TO STAY HOME.**

**IF SYMPTONS OCCUR WHILE AT KCKC CHILDREN WILL BE ISOLATED TO ONE AREA AWAY FROM OTHERS UNTIL PARENTS ARRIVE. PARENTS WILL BE CONTACTED FOR IMMEDIATE PICK UP. STAFF PRESENTING ANY SYMPTONS WILL BE SENT HOME FROM WORK. WE ARE WORKING VERY CLOSELY WITH PROVINCIAL HEALTH MINISTERS AND LICENSING OFFICERS GUIDELINES TO ENSURE THAT OUR CHILDREN FAMILIES AND STAFF REMAIN SAFE AND HEALTHY.**
