Definitions

"Local" - refers to the geographical area encompassing the City of Lloydminster and the broader Lakeland region. This term denotes the immediate vicinity, neighborhoods, communities, and surrounding municipalities that constitute this specific area. It pertains to the distinctive cultural, social, economic, and geographical attributes that collectively shape the identity of the City of Lloydminster and its neighboring locales within the Lakeland region. Within this context, "local" signifies the unique characteristics, resources, businesses, organizations, and individuals that contribute to the area's shared sense of community, development, and interconnectedness.

"Ticket prices" – will be set after confirmation from the theatre based on the performance type.

Project Objectives

- 1. **Promote Local Talent:** The performances will spotlight the diversity of artistic talents within our community, giving local artists an opportunity to gain exposure and recognition.
- Community Engagement: By offering affordable access to these showcases, we intend to
 encourage community members of all ages and backgrounds to come together and experience
 the joy of arts and culture.
- 3. **Cultural Enrichment:** Through a varied program encompassing music, theatre, and dance, we seek to enrich the cultural fabric of our community and provide an outlet for self-expression.
- 4. **Support Emerging Artists:** This project will provide a platform for emerging artists to share their work and build connections within the local creative scene.

Project Details

The performances will take place on: **Wednesday, March 27, Friday, May 10** and **Friday, June 20, 2024** at Vic Juba Community Theatre and Black Box, well-equipped community spaces. The schedule for each evening will focus on one genre with possibly a mix of music, theatre, and dance performances, with each artist or group allocated a specific time slot.

Application Process

Interested performers must fill out a Lloyd Locals Series application along with submit production details. The selection committee would evaluate the applications based on the following criteria. Applications to the series will be reviewed throughout the year as they are received.

- 1. **Residency Requirement:** The performer or performing group must be based within the Lloydminster area, demonstrating a clear and substantial connection to the local community.
- 2. **Artistic Merit:** The performer should possess a proven level of artistic excellence and demonstrate **FOUNDATIO** a high degree of skill and talent in their respective artistic discipline, whether it's music, theatre, dance, or another performing art.
- Community Engagement: The performer should have a track record of actively engaging with and contributing to the local community through their performances, workshops, or other relevant activities that promote arts and culture within Lloydminster.
- 4. **Innovative Content:** The proposed performance should offer innovative, unique, or culturally enriching content that resonates with the local audience and contributes to the diversity and vibrancy of the arts scene in Lloydminster.
- 5. **Feasibility and Planning:** The performer should present a well-structured draft proposal that outlines the details of the performance, including the intended program, technical requirements, timeline, and marketing plan. This demonstrates the performer's preparedness to effectively utilize the sponsored rental and ensure a successful event.

Meeting these criteria would demonstrate the performer's commitment to the local community, artistic excellence, and a positive contribution to the cultural landscape of Lloydminster.
