Fire pit construction includes approved materials, dimensions, and spark arrestor mesh size. Please refer to the Town of Castor web page under bylaws for a complete description of requirements pertaining to regulations on size, distance from structures, property line, and combustible materials. There is also a list of materials that are prohibited from being burned in a fire pit.
