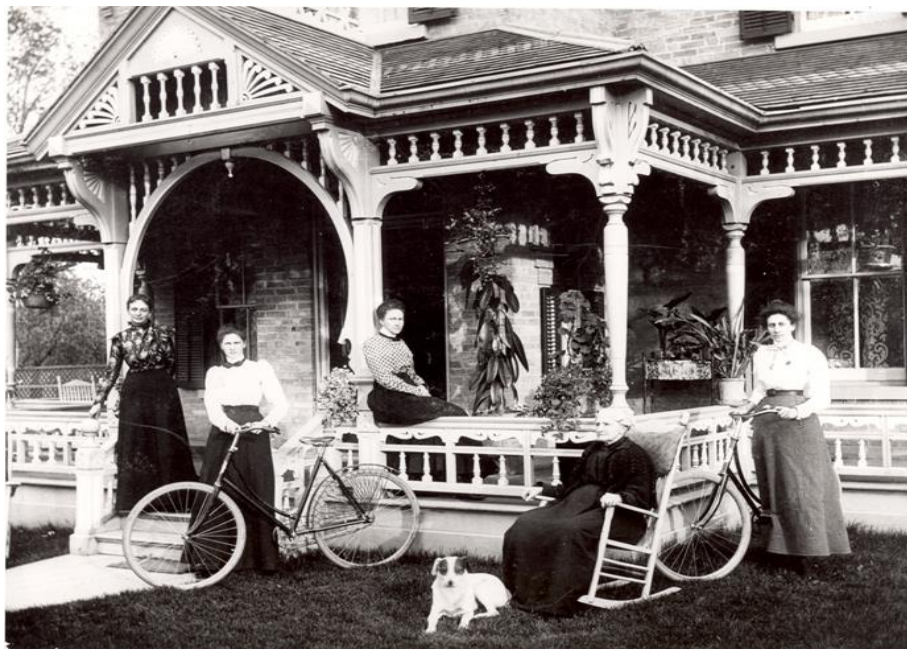

## A Brief History of Thomas Bouckley

Thomas Bouckley was born in Blackpool, England in 1904. His family moved to Oshawa when he was young. He then attended St. Gregory's School and Oshawa High School (now known as O'Neill Collegiate and Vocational Institute). After receiving his degree in Ceramic Engineering from the University of Toronto, Thomas started working as co-manager of the Jubilee Pavilion- an icon of Oshawa businesses. Thomas enlisted with the Canadian Special Forces during World War Two in which he served for six years. Upon his return to Oshawa, he joined his brother, Harold, in running Mike's place.

It was Thomas' father that first sparked his passion for photography. Like Thomas would amass later in life, his father had a large collection of historical photos of Oshawa. It was this collection, and his concern regarding the preservation of said collection, that spurred Thomas to learn about photography preservation and reproduction and begin his own collection. Thomas grew his collection by taking his own photos, acquiring photos, and reproducing photos. After meticulously documenting his collection, Thomas donated over 4000 images to the Robert McLaughlin Gallery in 1985. It is through Thomas' painstaking work that we now have a remarkable look at life in Oshawa as he and many others saw it.
