### Patron Information for Take In Days

#### Covid-19 Protocols

##### Personal Health

- If you are exhibiting symptoms of Covid-19 or have recently been in contact with someone who has contracted Covid-19 **DO NOT** come to the corrals
- **Symptoms**
  - **Cough**
  - **Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing**
  - **Fever**
  - **Sore Throat**
  - **Severe fatigue**
  - **Runny nose**
- Please bring your own personal hand sanitizer and other supplies

##### Social Distancing

- Please only bring the bare minimum of people required to unload the cattle
- All persons at corral days are required to remain two meters apart
- Only one person is allowed in the corral shack at one time
- Sitting in vehicles with someone from outside your household is not allowed

##### Personal Hygiene

- Use alcohol-based hand sanitizer if soap and water are not available, ensure hands are as free of organic matter as much as possible before using sanitizers
- When coughing or sneezing: do it into a tissue or the bend of your arm, not your hand
- Dispose of any tissues you have used as soon as possible in a plastic garbage bag, and wash your hands afterwards
- CRITICAL – avoid touching your eyes, nose, or mouth

##### Rules for acceptance of cattle has not changed

- All rules and regulations as stated on your deposit form and the Take In form remain in place
- All Trichomaniasis (Trich) rules related to your pasture remain. Bulls must be Trich tested and semen tested, and documentation provided
- All animals must be delivered in acceptable condition or will be sent home

**If at all possible please process your cattle at home to avoid having to go through the chute.**
