Earlier in March, Pastor Beth reached out to Bridge Street United Church in Belleville, Ontario to send prayers and concerns from our church to theirs, concerning the epidemic of drug addiction and the unhoused living on the streets. Beth and Glenn have a close connection to Belleville as Glenn's parents lived there, and Glenn's dad served the church. Below is the response from Bridge Street United. The council thought that you the congregation, would appreciate reading the email from Belleville.

Good evening Pastor Beth,

On behalf of our church, I extend our heartfelt gratitude for your thoughtful email and the prayers you've sent our way. Your understanding of the challenges we face, particularly in the context of the drug poisoning crisis, resonates deeply with us.

At Bridge Street Church, we have been actively involved in addressing the human impact of this crisis through our Drop-In program. It serves as a unique window into the struggles faced by individuals in our community, akin to what you may be experiencing in Victoria and Vancouver. Volunteers, staff, and congregants of Bridge Street Church have come to know people who access the Drop In as individuals and as neighbours. We have built relationships, celebrated successes, grieved setbacks, and mourned losses. It is difficult to see the suffering caused by homelessness, mental illness, substance use, and the toxic drug supply. It is frustrating to know the impacts on individuals, community, and health and social service systems and to feel that solutions are out of reach.

Your prayers provide solace and strength as we navigate these challenges, and your message serves as a reminder that we are not alone in our endeavors. We are grateful for the connections that bind our communities together and for fellow believers like you who share our dedication to the greater mission of spreading Christ's love and hope in a world in need.

May God continue to guide and bless your ministry at Cordova Bay United Church, and may our collective efforts bring about positive change in our respective communities.


Special Congregational Meeting
