



COUNCIL MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

REGULAR MEETING OF COUNCIL
November 24th, 2025

RCMP Report

Sgt. J. Houle attended the meeting and presented the Q2 Community Policing Report to Council.

Financial Updates

Council received the Cash Statement and Budget Update for the period ending October 31, 2025. The Town of Castor continues to maintain expenditures within budget and remains on target for the year.

Gas & Water Reconciliation Reports

- The gas system is reporting a 0.78% loss for 2025.
- The water system shows a 7.4% loss, with losses trending upward. Data from the watershed and distribution centre suggests a significant loss occurring along a major portion of the line, indicating a potential water break.

The Public Works Department provided a presentation outlining evidence of a probable leak on the feeder line supplying water to Castor and discussed technologies available to help locate it. After discussion, Council passed a motion directing Public Works to proceed with further investigation using Smartball Navigator technology. The project will begin in the future, with updates to follow.

Delegations & Requests

A funding request from the Red Deer River Watershed Alliance was received. Council accepted the correspondence as information and declined to provide funding.

Board & Committee Appointments

Councillor Kleinschroth was appointed to the East Central Rural Health Pilot Project. Shawn Peach, Beverly Morie, Angela Eggleston, Councillor Wismer, Sandy Shipton, Barbara Collier, Carol Ries and Councillor Sumegi were appointed to the Castor Library Board.

Tax Auction Update

Due to a legal clerical error, the 2025 Tax Auction has been adjourned to January 13, 2026.
