FEES AND COMMISSION

The entry fee is **\$10 per artwork**. Each artist may submit a maximum of **three (3) artworks** for consideration by the jury. Entry fees are **non-refundable**.

Payment may be made by **cash, cheque, Visa, MasterCard, or American Express**.

A **30% commission** will be retained by the St. Thomas-Elgin Public Art Centre on all artwork sold during the exhibition. The Art Centre does not collect HST. Artists are asked to price their work accordingly.

DELIVERY AND RESPONSIBILITY

Artwork must arrive ready for exhibition. All pieces must be properly framed or professionally presented and securely wired for hanging.

The St. Thomas-Elgin Public Art Centre will take reasonable care in handling submitted artwork; however, the Art Centre is not responsible for loss, theft, or damage to artwork, no matter the cause. Artwork will be insured during the exhibition.

JURY PROCESS

All submissions will be reviewed by a juror or jury panel. The juror's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into regarding the selection process.

Artists will be notified of the jury results by email prior to the opening reception.

IMAGE USE AND PROMOTION

By signing the entry form, artists agree to the terms and requirements of the exhibition and grant the St. Thomas-Elgin Public Art Centre permission to use images of submitted artwork for exhibition-related promotion, advertising, social media, website content, and archival purposes.

PICK-UP OF ARTWORK

Artwork must be picked up by **Saturday, October 24, 2026**, unless prior arrangements have been made with the Art Centre.

Artwork not collected by this date may become the property of the St. Thomas-Elgin Public Art Centre.

JURIED EXHIBITION DESCRIPTION

This juried exhibition invites original two-dimensional works of art that celebrate the artist's unique perspective. Artists are encouraged to submit work that reflects what they see, imagine, interpret, or create "in their view." Subject matter may be real or imagined.

Artwork must not exceed **48" x 48"** and must be suitably framed, professionally presented, and securely wired for hanging. The official exhibition label must be attached to the back of each submitted piece. Copies of the label are acceptable.

Please note that artwork that does not meet the stated criteria may be disqualified.

OPENING RECEPTION

The opening reception will be held on **Saturday, August 29, 2026, from 1:00–3:00 PM.**

SUBMISSIONS MUST INCLUDE

- Current membership
- Signed application form
- Artist biography
- CV or résumé
- Artwork with exhibition label attached to the back
- Submission fee

ENTRY DEADLINE

Submissions will be accepted until **Saturday, August 8, 2026, at 4:00 PM.**

No late submissions will be accepted.

Artwork must be hand delivered to the St. Thomas-Elgin Public Art Centre during regular operating hours for the jury process. Please check www.stepac.ca for current hours before delivering artwork.

ELIGIBILITY

Open to artists aged 18 and over who reside in Southwestern Ontario and are members in good standing of the St. Thomas-Elgin Public Art Centre.

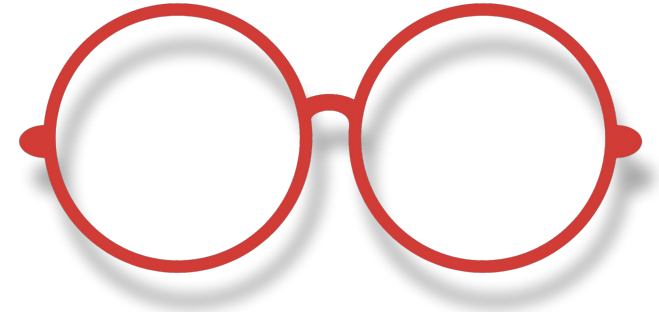
