Property Tax Installments

Anyone interested in going on a tax installment payment plan for the 2021 property taxes, please contact the Town Office at 403-549-3761. The plan provides for payment of your property taxes in equal monthly installments from January to December.

Business License Renewal

Reminder—Business Licenses must be renewed by January 31, 2021.

Rates as follows: In Town—\$30.00
Home Occupations—\$45.00
Regional—An additional \$80.00

Dog License Renewal

Dog Licenses are also due by January 31st. All dogs over the age of 3 months must be licensed.

Rates as follows: Sterilized—\$20.00
Unsterilized—\$35.00

After January 31st

Rates as follows: **Sterilized—\$30.00**
Unsterilized—\$45.00

- All returns should be placed in the outside Book Drop. A 72 hour quarantine of returned materials is **necessary to comply with Provincial guidelines.**
- The Library will be able to renew your library card or process new memberships during this phase.
