Presentation Overview:

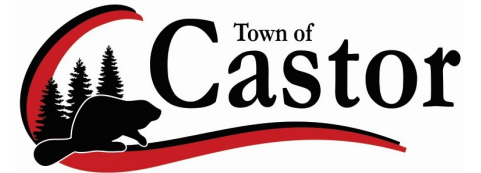
