This change is a result of the announcement that Alberta Infrastructure will no longer subsidize municipalities for the disposal of household hazardous waste. As of September 20th New public health restrictions came into effect that affect libraries. Mandatory public health measures include:

- 1) Mandatory masking indoors
- 2) Maintaining 2 meters distancing between members of different households; additionally, attendees (library patrons) must be with household members only or 2 close contacts if they live alone, and
- 3) Library capacity is limited to 1/3 fire code occupancy.

The Smart Hubs have been set up in Workflows with a **one week loan period and no renewals**. The user will be billed a replacement cost of \$50.00 when they are 28 days overdue. As we don't want them to be returned in the bookdrop or transited in the delivery vans, holds can't be placed on them. Users must go to the Library to pick them up and return them in the Library.

Scholastic Book Fair—is back again this fall! **The Stavely Municipal Library/Stavely School will be hosting the Book Fair from November 15th to November 19th** hopefully in person in the Library. A Virtual Book Fair will also be available for families who want to participate by shopping online. Those customers will receive shipments directly to their mailing address to avoid handling.
