# **BEEF CARCASS RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 1. **One entry per exhibitor**. 4-H entries must be tagged as a 4-H project and market animal record book kept. (Club is responsible for ensuring a record book is completed). 4-H and Open projects must have a PWF eartag and must also be tagged and registered under a **BUTTON** CCIA tag number. Failure to comply with this rule may cause forfeiture of prize money.
- 2. Steers entered in this class shall not be more than 22 months of age.
- 3. All entries must be delivered to KAM LAKEVIEW MEATS in CHERRY CREEK, BC Date & Time To Be Announced – \*WILL BE APPROX 1-2 WEEKS PRIOR TO FAIR\*. This will allow for a proper slaughter and hanging time for the carcass for a fair evaluation. \*\*\*(Weighing facilities unavailable at processing plant; therefore 4-H entries must organize their own weighing to get a live weight for their record book)
- 4. Open Entries don't have to be halter broken; 4-H entries are not required to be halter broken as a PWF rule, but are subject to 4-H club's project halter breaking club policy. 4-H BC Regulation is that Carcass projects be shown at club Achievement day.
- 5. All entries shown in this class are to be slaughtered as arranged for by the PWF and carcasses scored by officer of the Livestock Division.
- 6. ALL CARCASSES MUST BE SOLD THROUGH THE SALE at a 6% commission to PWF.
- 7. The Exhibitor (or representative of that exhibitor) selling a carcass must be present in the sale ring, with required information which will be supplied by the Carcass Committee. If a contributor is not present and misses their spot on the sale sheet, they will automatically drop to the end of the sale.
- 8. **4-H & Open Online Entries** accompanied by fees, must be received by **current year's deadline per the entry website.**
- 9. Open Carcass post entries will be accepted by the PWF Committee up to August 15. Post entry fee is \$25.00 (non taxable), plus regular entry fees and applicable taxes.
- 10. All entries in this division are subject to the General Rules and Regulations of the PWF.
- 11. The top 4 carcasses will return to the PWF for display and will be eligible for prize money. Carcass Awards will be handed out during the Saturday Night Lamb & Beef Group Competitions.
- 12. <u>It is requested that each entry supply a photograph of their carcass animal for display on</u> <u>Carcass Cooler and for the Sale Powerpoint.</u> *Refer to website for current file submission procedure.*



13. There may be limits on entries due to number of spots booked at the processing plant – however 4-H entries will be given priority and open entries will be first come first serve for any remaining spots.

#### All competitors must pay a \$ 10.00 Exhibitor fee.

Open Carcass post entries will be accepted by the PWF Committee up to August 15. Post entry fee is \$25.00 (non taxable), plus regular entry fees and applicable taxes.

### **SALE RULES**

- 1. Carcasses will be sold on the basis of weight.
- 2. All carcasses will be sold through the sale and subject to a six percent (6%) commission.
- 3. The Carcasses will be sold according to the order of sale of the Provincial Winter Fair for that year.
- 4. The Exhibitor (or representative of that exhibitor) selling a carcass must be present in the sale ring, with required information which will be supplied by the Carcass Committee. If a contributor is not present and misses their spot on the sale sheet, they will automatically drop to the end of the sale.
- 5. Carcass animals will be sold in blocks throughout the sale.
- 6. All Carcasses will be sold by auction. *However, the Provincial Winter Fair Carcass Committee has the right to withhold a B Grade or a Dark Cutter Carcass from the PWF Livestock Auction.*
