EUCCHARISTIC ROSARY CONGRESS

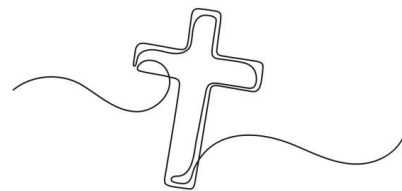
