Summary of February 2014 Meeting:

Shawn Connors of Scotia Macleod spoke about retirement. When we retire, we will have multiple sources of income. Instead of the one income we are accustomed to, we will be withdrawing from our savings, and living within a budget. He discussed the 5 key risks to retirement income:

- Longevity- people are living longer so you have to factor in for a longer period of income required.
- Inflation- how even a low inflation rate can erode the purchasing power of a retiree.
- Health Care- although there is a public health care system it is changing and it is safe to say that we will pay more for health care in the future then what we pay now.
- Withdrawal Rate- What percentage of your total retirement savings do you think you can afford to withdraw each year without running out of money? Anything above 4% is too much if planning for a long retirement.
- Asset Allocation- At a 4% withdrawal rate in a moderate portfolio, clients should get the advantages of the market in the up years and protection of the portfolio in the down years to ensure income throughout retirement.

Shawn also mentioned the Rule of 72. Rule 72 is where you can calculate based on your interest rate how long it takes for your money to double. Take 72 divided by the interest rate for example 10% would take 7.2 years to double. This is to help people decide where there money needs to be invested in terms of "risk" if you have time on your hands that your investments should be in high risk and as you get closer to retirement that you should move them to lower risk options.

He also talked about having a written plan of how much you will need based on your current lifestyle to cover your essential expenses housing, insurance and food, and your discretionary expenses travel, leisure activities. That you should review your plan annually to make sure you are still on track.
