

## The Girl's Afterschool Program

The Girls Wellness Afterschool Program is open to girls ages 11- 16, programming is offered every Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 3:30pm – 6:30pm, at the Selkirk United Church. The program focuses on building healthy relationships, learning life skills including cooking/baking, sewing, crafts, games, volunteer work in the community, and showcasing their skills/talents all within a safe environment.



## Cultural Club

The Cultural Club is offered every Wednesday from 6:00pm-8:00pm for families with children ages 5 and up. The first session ran from June - October of 2022. We have our second session starting January 18<sup>th</sup>, 2023 for 10 weeks at Ruth Hooker School. The children participate in traditional teachings and language classes, while the parents and older children learn to make mitts, ribbon skirts and moccasins.



## Community Volunteer Tax Program

The Community Volunteer Tax Program is a collaboration between the Selkirk Community Renewal Corporation and the Canada Revenue Agency. SCRC has volunteers available to complete tax returns for free. This program is available to modest income and simple tax situations, including adults 65 years and older, housing-insecure individuals, Indigenous Peoples, modest-income individuals, newcomers, persons with disabilities and students residing in the City of Selkirk. Simple tax situations including but not limited to; if an individual has no income or if their income comes from these sources: employment, pension, benefits, such as the Canada Pension Plan, Old Age Security, disability insurance, employment insurance, and social assistance
